Meeting:

The Parish Council and Finance Committee met on Sun. July 22, to hear a presentation by Tatiana Govoni, a summer parishioner, concerning the finances and status of the website and social media accounts that she has created for the parish.

The website, ourladyvt.org, and the Twitter and Facebook accounts have been active since March and all 3 have seen plenty of activity by viewers. She also runs Facebook ads for our various events. June's response was 1200+ views (VT/NH) for a weekly ad, with 150+ people responding and forwarding to others. July's ad trended higher.

She posts regularly to both Twitter and Facebook, and regularly maintains the website. Bulletins, daily Mass schedules (with Mass intentions), events and other items are posted on the website.

Annual costs associated with hosting of the website, including added security/privacy options, website hosting and domain registration is \$281./annum. Tatiana has offered to continue to absorb all costs of this project on behalf of the parish. We are very grateful for her contribution!
